

Woman's Club of Hartland Donation Vision Statement

The Woman's Club of Hartland is committed to providing support and financial assistance to our community, supporting various social causes and community projects through its donation process. The vision and objectives of the Woman's Club of Hartland are intended to provide guidance to the Donation Committee, which is a special committee appointed by the President on an annual basis, in compliance with By-Laws Article V. The President is an exofficio member of all committees. The Woman's Club of Hartland vision and objectives, in this regard, are:

- To strive for community improvements and enrichment, including support for members of our community that need assistance.
- To provide aid and assistance to nonprofit organizations within Waukesha County that focus on the following areas for low-income individuals, veterans, and families:
 - housing assistance,
 - food, clothing, and bedding assistance, and
 - health services, including mental health.
- To provide our members with opportunities for fellowship and service.
- To stress the concepts of programs of the GFWC:
GFWC members work in their communities to support the arts, preserve natural resources, advance education, promote healthy lifestyles, and encourage civic involvement, issues related to domestic and sexual violence awareness/prevention, and advocating for children.

Additional guidance for the Donation Committee includes the following:

- Donation Committee should be responsible for reviewing any Donation Applications submitted from Club members. The review should ensure the request aligns with the Woman's Club of Hartland vision and objectives.
- The Donation Committee should consider the Woman's Club of Hartland vision when recommending new recipients of our donation funds.
- The Donation Committee should assess the ongoing relationships that the Woman's Club of Hartland has developed over the years to determine if repeat funding should be considered for certain organizations.
- Determine if there are some natural partnerships that align with the Woman's Club of Hartland that tie to service projects/volunteer opportunities that we could establish with certain organizations to fulfill our vision to "provide our members with opportunities for fellowship and service."
